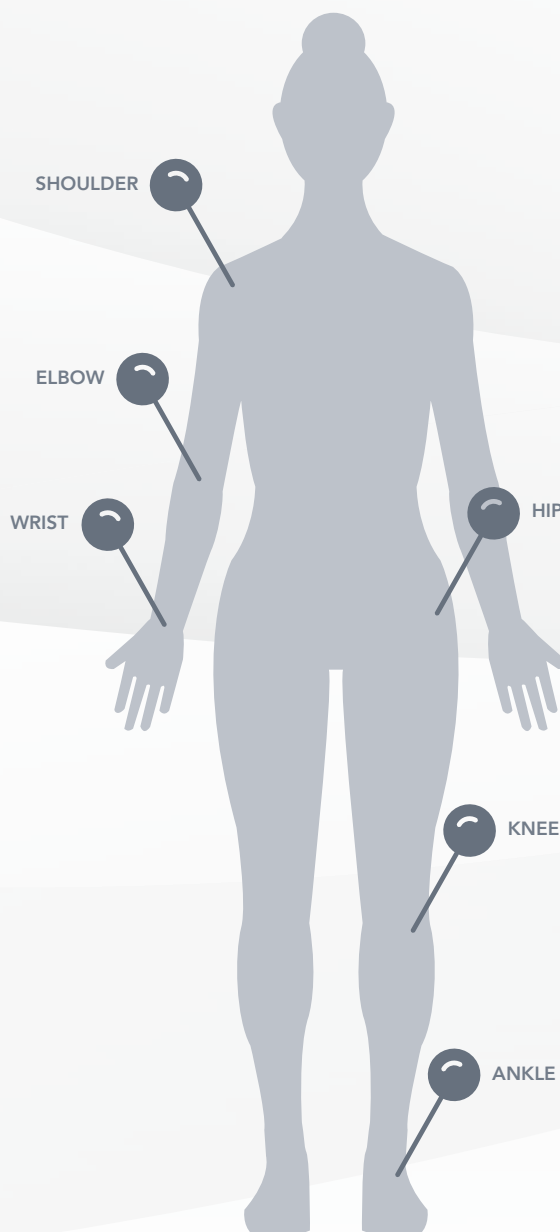

Health and Safety at the AIUM's Education Center

Important update: In an effort to ensure the health and safety of the faculty, models, staff, and participants, everyone participating in this course will be required to wear a mask **and** be fully vaccinated or provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours of the start of the course on September 24.

Vaccination Requirement

- Verification of vaccination must be provided by either paper or electronic documentation before entry to the course (including photo of card). A person is considered fully vaccinated 2 weeks after the second dose of a two-dose series, or two weeks after a single dose of a one-dose vaccine. This means that a person must receive all required doses of the vaccine(s) by September 9.
- The AIUM will accept proof of vaccination against COVID-19 with a vaccine authorized by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) or by the World Health Organization (WHO).
- Attendees may bring a physical copy of their vaccine card, show a photo of their vaccine card, or bring a printout from their medical provider or state's vaccine registry.
- If a person is unable to be vaccinated, they must provide proof of a PCR or Rapid COVID-19 antigen test taken within 72 hours of the start of the course. **At-home tests will not be accepted.**

Mask Requirement
